



Closing meeting

26 May 2026

The closing event brings together all project partners to reflect on and evaluate the outcomes of the Visegrad project. The primary aim of the meeting is to summarise the key results of the trial lecture series, including experiences with the blended learning format, student engagement, and feedback collected through Moodle.

An additional key outcome of the project is the set of disciplinary systematic reviews developed by the partners. These written outputs synthesise the main theoretical and empirical insights from each field and provide a strong academic foundation for the course. During the meeting, we will review these materials and discuss the possibility of further developing them into joint publications, making them accessible to a broader academic audience.

In addition to reviewing the project achievements, the meeting will provide a space to discuss future collaboration opportunities. In particular, we will explore the potential for developing a joint research proposal within the Horizon Europe framework, building on the interdisciplinary cooperation established during the project.

We also aim to identify concrete next steps for sustaining and expanding our collaboration beyond the current project.
