

Thesis Topic Selection Guide for Students

in their BA (except for BA in psychology) or MA programme

In the NEPTUN System, the topic chosen after prior consultation with the prospective supervisor shall be recorded.

To apply for a thesis topic, go to the NEPTUN menu under "Menu/Studies/Degree Thesis" and click the "Thesis Application Start" button.

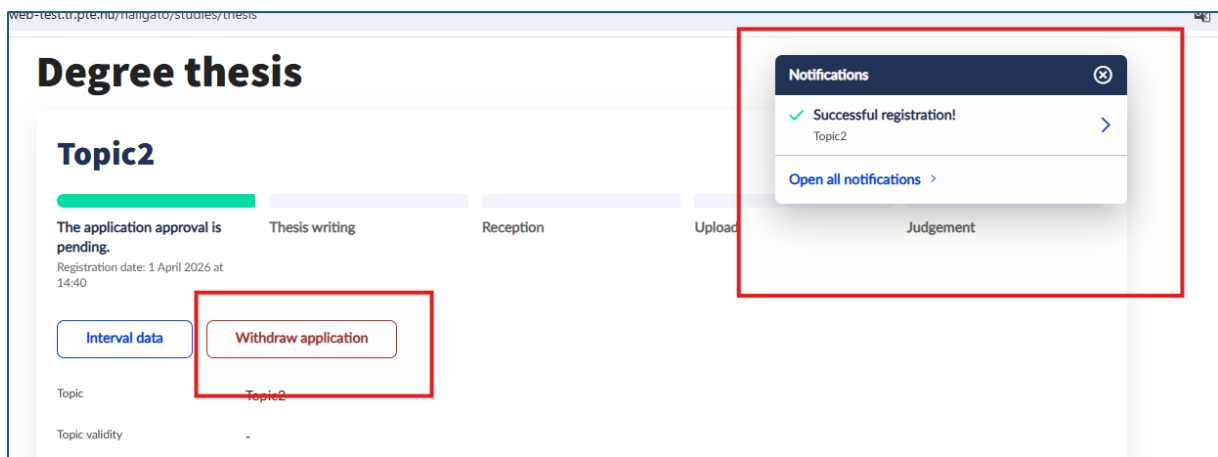

By clicking the Register button the following window will pop up:

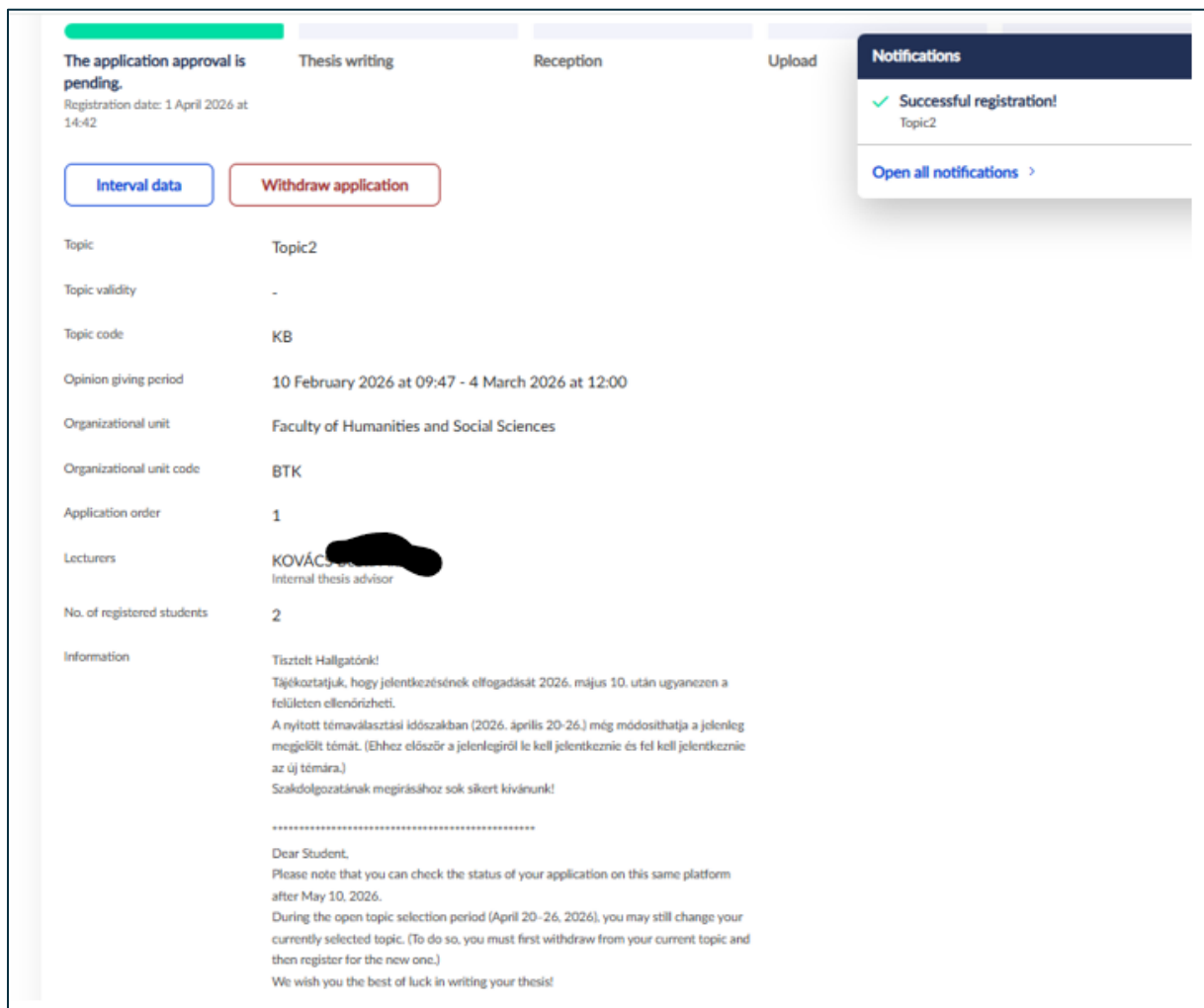
