Proposals will be evaluated by a team of reviewers according to each of the following criteria:

0-5 scores can be given for each criteria. (Total: 30 points)

- 1. The abstract is well written and organized, offering background and context to show how the project fits into the overall discipline in a meaningful and novel way.
- 2. Theoretical framework
- 3. State, in clear terms, the central research question and the purpose of the research.
- 4. Provide a brief discussion of the research methodology.
- 5. Relevance, currency, appropriateness and significance of the topic/issue/problem
- 6. General quality, structure and style of the abstract.
